This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") on information regarding Latimer Anthony Taylor, M.D. ("Dr. Taylor"). Dr. Taylor admits, and the Board finds and concludes, that:

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

The Board is a body duly organized under the laws of North Carolina and is the proper party to bring this proceeding under the authority granted it in Article 1 of Chapter 90 of the North Carolina General Statutes and the rules and regulations promulgated thereto.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Dr. Taylor is a physician licensed by the Board on or about September 19, 1998, license number 9801527.

At all times relevant hereto, Dr. Taylor practiced internal medicine in Charlotte, North Carolina.

On or about November 4, 2013, during a telephone conversation with Patient A, a female, Dr. Taylor made inappropriate and unprofessional comments.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The above-described conduct constitutes a departure from and failure to conform to the ethics of the medical profession within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6), which is grounds for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit Dr. Taylor's license to practice medicine.

### PROCEDURAL STIPULATIONS

Dr. Taylor acknowledges and agrees that the Board has jurisdiction over him and over the subject matter of this case.

Dr. Taylor knowingly waives his right to any hearing and to any judicial review or appeal in this case.

Dr. Taylor would like to resolve this matter without the need for more formal proceedings.

The Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this case as set forth below.

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, with Dr. Taylor' consent, it is ORDERED that:

1. Dr. Taylor is hereby REPRIMANDED.
2. Within six (6) months of the date of this Consent Order, Dr. Taylor shall submit himself for a comprehensive assessment with Dr. Eugenia Gullick, Ph.D. with Gullick & Associates in Charlotte, North Carolina, and follow all recommendations made by the assessment facility or provider,

including, but not limited to, any recommendation that Dr. Taylor complete a period of remediation, training, or proctoring.

3. Dr. Taylor shall obey all laws. Furthermore, he shall obey all rules and regulations related to the practice of medicine.

4. Dr. Taylor shall notify the Board in writing of any change in his address within ten (10) days of the change.

5. Dr. Taylor shall meet with the Board or members of the Board for an investigative interview at such times as requested by the Board.

6. If Dr. Taylor fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend or revoke his license or to deny any application he might make in the future or then have pending for a license.

7. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Taylor and the Board and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.

8. Dr. Taylor hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Consent Order be served on him.



Upon execution by Dr. Taylor and the Board, this Consent Order shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof. Additionally, it will be reported to persons, entities, agencies and clearinghouses as required and permitted by law.

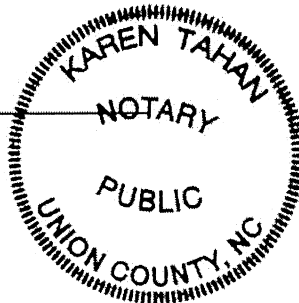
